### MORTGAGE FORBEARANCE

If you have been affected by COVID-19 and you're worried about how to make your mortgage payments, there may be a couple of options available to you. The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) have announced mortgage payment relief options for single-family homeowners with FHA-insured mortgages.

### MORTGAGE CONT.

If you're a homeowner with FHA, USDA, VA, or have mortgages backed by Fannie Mae or Freddie Mac, you can request a forbearance (allows you to temporarily lower or pause your loan payments for a longer period of time) on your payments for up to 6 months, with a possible extension for another 6 months without fees, penalties, or extra interest.

If you're a homeowner experiencing financial hardship due to COVID-19, please contact your mortgage servicer immediately to find out if they qualify for forbearance. For more information about mortgage forbearance and other options available for homeowners.
